Ezekiel matches these passages as well but also seems to differ in significant ways.⁶</p>

¹ There is a marked break between v.35 & v.36; Jerome indicated that the Jews of his day (c.300-400 AD) viewed v.36 on as a future period; v.35 & earlier refer to Antiochus.

⁴ This means *YHWH judges*; Since there is no known valley of the name Jehoshaphat, some believe this is a description of an event rather than the name of a location.

⁵ from *har meghiddo*, "Mount of Megiddo"; while unclear, some believe this refers to tel Megiddo which is a mound at the head of a pass through the Carmel Ridge, which overlooks the Valley of Jezreel from the west; many battles have been fought on the plain of Megiddo also known as the plain of Esdraelon (note Dan.11:45: it does lie between the three seas to the east and west (Mediterranean, Galilean, Dead) and Jerusalem to the south.)
