**Joel** (c.875-750; against Egypt & Edom; over 3 centuries in advance)

Joel 3:19 Egypt shall be a desolation, And Edom shall be a desolate wilderness, For the violence against the children of Judah, Because they have shed innocent blood in their land.

**Obadiah** (c.854 or later; against Edom; over 3 centuries in advance) Obadiah The entire book is devoted to this prophecy

Amos (c.767-753; against Syria, Philistia, Phonecia, Edom, Ammon & Moab; around 2 centuries in advance)

Isaiah (c.740-680; against Egypt & Babylon; 100-150 years before it happened)

- Isa 19:1 The oracle concerning Egypt. Behold, the Lord is riding on a swift cloud and is about to come to Egypt; The idols of Egypt will tremble at His presence, And the heart of the Egyptians will melt within them.
  Isa 19:6 The canals will emit a stench, The streams of Egypt will thin out and dry up; The reeds and rushes will rot away.
- Isa 19:10 And the pillars of Egypt will be crushed; All the hired laborers will be grieved in soul.

Isa 19:12 Well then, where are your wise men? Please let them tell you, And let them understand what the Lord of hosts Has purposed against Egypt.

- Isa 19:13 The princes of Zoan have acted foolishly, The princes of Memphis are deluded; Those who are the cornerstone of her tribes Have led Egypt astray.
- Isa 19:14 The Lord has mixed within her a spirit of distortion; They have led Egypt astray in all that it does, As a drunken man staggers in his vomit.
- Isa 19:15 There will be no work for Egypt Which its head or tail, its palm branch or bulrush, may do.
- Isa 19:18 In that day five cities in the land of Egypt will be speaking the language of Canaan and swearing allegiance to the Lord of hosts; one will be called the City of Destruction.
- Isa 19:19 In that day there will be an altar to the Lord in the midst of the land of Egypt, and a pillar to the Lord near its border.
- Isa 19:20 It will become a sign and a witness to the Lord of hosts in the land of Egypt; for they will cry to the Lord because of oppressors, and He will send them a Savior and a Champion, and He will deliver them.
- Isa 19:21 Thus the Lord will make Himself known to Egypt, and the Egyptians will know the Lord in that day. They will even worship with sacrifice and offering, and will make a vow to the Lord and perform it.
- Isa 19:22 The Lord will strike Egypt, striking but healing; so they will return to the Lord, and He will respond to them and will heal them.
- Isa 19:23 In that day there will be a highway from Egypt to Assyria, and the Assyrians will come into Egypt and the Egyptians into Assyria, and the Egyptians will worship with the Assyrians.

Isa 19:24 In that day Israel will be the third party with Egypt and Assyria, a blessing in the midst of the earth,

Isa 19:25 whom the Lord of hosts has blessed, saying, "Blessed is Egypt My people, and Assyria the work of My hands, and Israel My inheritance."

## Habakkuk (c.608-597; against Babylon; 50 years in advance)

Hab.1:6 I am raising up the Chaldeans, that bitter and hasty nation, who march through the breadth of the earth, to seize dwellings not their own.

2:7-16 speaking of Babylon <sup>7</sup>Will not your debtors suddenly arise, and those awake who will make you tremble? Then you will be spoil for them. <sup>8</sup>Because you have plundered many nations, all the remnant of the peoples shall plunder you, for the blood of man and violence to the earth, to cities and all who dwell in them. <sup>9</sup> "Woe to him who gets evil gain for his house, to set his nest on high, to be safe from the reach of harm! <sup>10</sup> You have devised shame for your house by cutting off many peoples; you have forfeited your life...<sup>12</sup>"Woe to him who builds a town with blood and founds a city

**Daniel** (c.605-539; against Babylon; just a few years in advance up to the night of its demise)

- Daniel 5 The handwriting on the wall

**Jeremiah** (c.627-586; against Egypt & Babylon; just a few years in advance)

- "And I shall set fire to the temples of the gods of Egypt, and he will burn them and take them captive. So Jer 43:12 he will wrap himself with the land of Egypt as a shepherd wraps himself with his garment, and he will depart from there safely.
- Jer 43:13 "He will also shatter the obelisks of Heliopolis, which is in the land of Egypt; and the temples of the gods of Egypt he will burn with fire." '
- Jer 44:1 The word that came to Jeremiah for all the Jews living in the land of Egypt, those who were living in Migdol, Tahpanhes, Memphis, and the land of Pathros, saying,
- provoking Me to anger with the works of your hands, burning sacrifices to other gods in the land of Egypt, Jer 44:8 where you are entering to reside, so that you might be cut off and become a curse and a reproach among all the nations of the earth?

"Thus says the Lord, 'Behold, I am going to give over Pharaoh Hophra king of Egypt to the hand of his

- Jer 44:30 enemies, to the hand of those who seek his life, just as I gave over Zedekiah king of Judah to the hand of Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon, who was his enemy and was seeking his life.' "
- To Egypt, concerning the army of Pharaoh Neco king of Egypt, which was by the Euphrates River at Jer 46:2 Carchemish, which Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon defeated in the fourth year of Jehoiakim the son of Josiah, king of Judah:
- Jer 46:8 Egypt rises like the Nile, Even like the rivers whose waters surge about; And He has said, "I will rise and cover that land; I will surely destroy the city and its inhabitants."
- Jer 46:13 This is the message which the Lord spoke to Jeremiah the prophet about the coming of Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon to smite the land of Egypt:
- Jer 46:14 "Declare in Egypt and proclaim in Migdol, Proclaim also in Memphis and Tahpanhes; Say, 'Take your stand and get yourself ready, For the sword has devoured those around you.'
- Jer 46:17 "They cried there, 'Pharaoh king of Egypt is but a big noise; He has let the appointed time pass by!'
- Jer 46:20 "Egypt is a pretty heifer, But a horsefly is coming from the north—it is coming!
- Jer 46:24 "The daughter of Egypt has been put to shame, Given over to the power of the people of the north."
- Jer 46:25 The Lord of hosts, the God of Israel, says, "Behold, I am going to punish Amon of Thebes, and Pharaoh, and Egypt along with her gods and her kings, even Pharaoh and those who trust in him.
